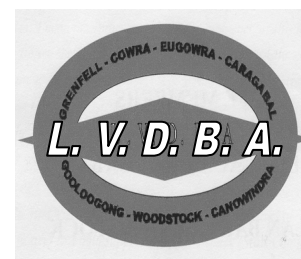

## **ZONE 5 PENNANT FINALS**

### INFORMATION FOR CLUBS COMPETING AND CLUBS HOSTING PLAY

#### COMPETING CLUBS REQUIREMENT

- 1) Clubs winning District Pennants are required to submit to their Districts Association a list of names and registration number of players and reserves selected to play in Zone Finals  
  
District Secretary to check and validate player's eligibility and forward as soon as possible to Zone Secretary
- 2) Players must be prepared to start games at 9.00 am (morning games) - 1.00 pm (afternoon games). Practice ends will commence 15 minutes before starting time. Managers must be at the Club by 8.15 am and 12.15 pm respectively, to allow sufficient time for necessary procedures to be carried out.
- 3) Lunches for Zone Round Robin
  - (i) It is a requirement of Host Clubs to notify Visiting Clubs of what catering facility they intend to offer and at what cost .
  - (ii) Visiting Clubs are responsible for notifying Host Club of their catering needs and pay up front one (1) week before playing date.
  - (iii) If payment for catering is required in advance then the timing for this payment is to be of mutual agreement other wise one (1) week before.
  - (iv) Both parties when making catering arrangements must always be mindful of not delaying starting times. (clause 2)
- 4) Attire: Players and Officials shall conform with those requirements as laid down in BY-LAW 8 of the RNSWBA .
- 5) Only players wearing bowls attire will be presented with badges. Two (2) reserves will be eligible for a badge. Side Captains will be presented with a special badge.
- 6) Clubs should ensure at all times there is to be unimpeded view of the Master Score Board.  
  
Side Captains must ensure that the Master Score Board is kept up to date at all times.  
  
Seconds must keep rink scoreboards up dated at all times.
- 7) Each player will have affixed to his bowls the coloured discs appropriate to his Club and supplied by same.
- 8) Clubs shall provide their own identification (four) Board Markers.

## HOST CLUB REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Club will be available to receive players no later than 8.30 am
- 2) A complimentary cup of tea or coffee would be most welcome on arrival
- 3) Lunches for Zone Round Robin
  - i) It is a requirement of Host Clubs to notify Visiting Clubs of what catering facility they intend to offer and at what cost.
  - ii) The host club will be responsible for all moneys to be collected from participating sides for meals
  - iii) Ensure that lunches provided are of an acceptable standard
  - iv) Lunches should be available as soon as games are completed, allowing players to be back on the green in half an hour if required
- 4) Clubs will appoint an official to work in conjunction with the Zone and District Officials in the organization and running of the matches
- 5) Clubs are required to supply a Master Board, displaying draw sheets for ALL Pennant Grade Finals
- 6) Clubs should provide a contact person to answer telephone enquiries and be conversant with progress scores. A mobile phone or two-way radios have been used by some Clubs.
- 7) Clubs will ensure that the best greens possible are provided

## DISTRICT AND ZONE RESPONSIBILITY

Subject to oversight by Zone - where appropriate and necessary - it will be in the hands of the Host District to:-

- a) Make available the best possible greens in the District
- b) If called upon, assist visiting Districts to find suitable accommodation
- c) Ensure that Host Clubs have appropriate resources

Zone Match Committee will arrange dates of play and conduct of games.

- a) Utilising District Match Committee
- b) Utilising Club Match Committee and Members
- c) Utilising District Umpire

## ZONE 5 PENNANT FINALS CONDITION OF PLAY 2012

- A) All matches to be played within the Lachlan Valley DBA.
- B) 1: Where there are (3) three or more Districts nominated in any grade 1-7 a Round Robin Series will be played to determine Zone winners
- 2: Where there are only (2) two Districts nominated in any grade 1-7, this match shall be by Knock out play to determine Zone winners
- C) Round Robin Series
- 1: If there are (5) five or more sides in any one grade, the first round shall be as follows:

- The remainder of the Round Robin to be played by open draw.
- 2: Any side not having an opponent in Round one will be declared as having a bye in round one.
- 3: All first round games to be played on or before 3<sup>th</sup> June 2012
- D) Where only (3) three Districts nominate in any one grade
- 1: The side that has the longest distance to travel will have the first round bye
- 2: Round 2 shall be played between the loser of Round 1 and the team with the first round bye.
- 3: If Round 1 finishes with a drawn result, the side captains will toss and the loser of the toss will play round 2
- E) Number of Ends
- 1: Round Robin Series – 63 ends – (21 per rink). Dead Ends do not count.
- F) Inclement Weather
- 1: If inclement weather, bad light or other justifiable caused should prevent the completing of a match, the match shall be declared completed if at least 54 ends in aggregate have been played. This will apply per session. (am/pm) Note: am time to finish 1.00pm
- 2: If 54 ends in aggregate have not been played the match will continue as soon as practicable possible within the time allocated for the Round Robin, and if that cannot be achieved, the match/es will be continued the **following weekend**. The Match Committee will announce fresh times/dates upon which the match/es will be continued at **same venue**.
- 3: Only with the agreement of the Zone Match Committee will the original host venue be changed after a washout weekend.

- 4: At all times the controlling body must endeavour to reach a conclusion on programmed weekend and if necessary change the number of ends to achieve this. Note: Zone Match Committee must be kept informed and agree to any change to the Conditions of Play.

G) Number of Ends

- 1: Knockout Play – 63 ends – (21 per rink) Dead Ends do not count.  
Round Robin Play - 63 ends - (21 per rink) Dead Ends do not count.

H) Method of Scoring

- 1: Round Robin play – side with the highest aggregate number of shots shall score (2) two points, a tie (1) one, losing no points.
- 2: If, at the completion of the Round Robin play, two or more sides are equal in points, the side with the greatest margin of net shots shall be the winner. (Total shots “for” minus total shots “against” equal net shots”. If the foregoing methods fail to determine the winning side then the side with the lowest total of shots scored against it, shall be the winner.
- 3: Knockout play, the side, in aggregate scores the greater number of shots up on the Master board

I) Players eligibility

A player to be eligible to play Zone Finals must have played a minimum of (50%) fifty percent of their respective Districts Pennant competition in any grade in the current season. Subject to Law 4.23 RNSWBA State “Conditions of Play 2012”.

J) Side Manager/Captain

Each side will be responsible for appointing a Side Manager. The Side Manager shall be the side’s representative in all matters concerning the playing of the match (subject to duties of the Umpire). His duties shall be completion of Pennant Result sheets, drawing of the cards, tossing for the mat and collection of meal moneys.

K) Practice

Players may practice on the venue green up to the commencement of trial ends, providing that space is available and the Controlling Body approves. The Controlling body shall advise the rinks allocated for each round 2 hours before the starting time of each round.

L) General Conditions

- 1: If any match in progress, or not commenced is washed out, and the result of these matches would have no bearing on the winner of the competition, with permission of the controlling body, those matches do not have to be completed – with the proviso, if the host club has made preparations for meals, eg: lunch after Sunday morning game, then the clubs concerned shall be responsible for paying for 14 meals
- 2: Any matters arising not covered by Zone 5 “Conditions of Play 2012” are to refer to the current RNSWBA “Conditions of Play 2012” or current laws of Bowls Australia
